A separate form should be completed by each person to be assessed. Children born after 16 September 1975 may be included in a parent’s form or may complete a separate form if seeking assessment in their own right.

You should complete as much of the form as you can, and attach documents to support your answers where possible. If there are any matters you are aware of but you do not have supporting documents, you can make a declaration about those matters at Question 23.
