This form is only for use by state/territory authorised agencies to nominate General Skilled Migration visa applicants.

Purpose

The form can be used for nominating applicants for:

- provisional visas – subclasses 475 and 487.
- permanent visas where the nominee's occupation is on the relevant state/territory baseline list of occupations.
- permanent visas where the nominee's occupation is not on the relevant state/territory baseline list of occupations (conditions apply).

Nomination forms should be sent directly to the department by the authorising agency. Regional Certifying Bodies are not authorised to submit off-list nominations.

Important – Please read this information carefully before you complete the nomination. Once you have completed the nomination, we strongly advise that you keep a copy for your records.

About the information you give

The Department of Immigration and Citizenship (the department) is authorised to collect information provided on this form under Part 2 of the *Migration Act 1958* 'Control of Arrival and Presence of Non-Citizens'. The information provided will be used for assessing nominations under the General Skilled Migration (GSM) program, and for other purposes relating to the administration of the Migration Act, for example, to assist migrants with settling in Australia or for ensuring compliance with visa conditions.

The information provided might also be disclosed to agencies who are authorised to receive information relating to adoption, border control, business skills, citizenship, education, health, assessment, health insurance, health services, law enforcement, payment of pensions and benefits, taxation, review of decisions and regulation of migration agents.

The information form 993i *Safeguarding your personal information*, available from offices of the department, gives details of agencies to which your information might be disclosed.

Consent to communicate electronically

The department will use a range of means to communicate with you. Please note that using electronic communications such as e-mail is optional and that an e-mail address is not necessary. The department will also contact people by mail, telephone or in person. However, if you have an e-mail address, this may speed up communication.

The department may need to convey sensitive information about your nomination to you. Electronic communications, unless adequately encrypted, are not secure and may be viewed by others or interfered with. Should you choose to use e-mail, the department will only use your e-mail address for the purpose for which you have provided it. It will not be added to any mailing list and will not be disclosed without your consent.

If you authorise another person to receive documents on your behalf and they wish to be contacted electronically, their signature is required on the form to indicate their consent to this form of communication.
