



A sponsorship from a State or Territory government agency authorised for the purpose of sponsorship is required for the Investor Retirement visa.

You must include this signed and stamped sponsorship form with your completed visa application form 147 *Application for a temporary residence visa (non-business)*.

This sponsorship form and your completed visa application form must be lodged with the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (the department) within the validity date of your sponsorship. Please check the validity date at the end of this form and if the validity date will expire prior to you lodging your application then your State/Territory sponsoring government agency will require you to seek a new sponsorship from them.

This sponsorship will cover the applicant, and their spouse if included in the application.

State or Territory government agencies must notify the department's Perth Business Skills Processing Centre if this sponsorship is withdrawn.

**About the information you give in this form**

The department is authorised to collect information provided on this form under Part 2 of the *Migration Act 1958* 'Control of Arrival and presence of Non-Citizens'. The information provided will be used for assessing your eligibility for a visa to travel, enter and remain in Australia and for other purposes relating to the administration of the Migration Act, for example, to assist migrants with settling in Australia or for ensuring compliance with the Migration Act.

The information provided might also be disclosed to agencies who are authorised to receive information relating to adoption, border control, business skills, citizenship, education, health assessment, health insurance, health services, law enforcement, payment of pensions and benefits, taxation, review of decisions and State/Territory economic development departments and agencies which help business skills migrants access government business information services.

The department has authority under the *Migration Act 1958* to collect a range of personal identifiers from non-citizens, including visa applicants, in certain circumstances.
