



An endorsement from a state or territory government agency authorised for the purpose is required for the Investor Retirement visa.

You must include this signed and stamped endorsement form with your completed visa application form 147 *Application for a temporary residence visa (non-business)*.

This endorsement form and your completed visa application form must be lodged with the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (the department) within the validity date of your endorsement. Please check the validity date at the end of this form and if the validity date will expire prior to you lodging your application then you will need to seek a new endorsement from the state/territory government agency.

This endorsement will cover the applicant, and his or her partner if included in the application. Partner means a spouse or de facto partner (including a same-sex partner).

State or territory government agencies must notify the department's Perth Business Skills Processing Centre if this endorsement is withdrawn.

Integrity of application

The department is committed to maintaining the integrity of the visa and citizenship programs. Please be aware that if you provide us with fraudulent documents or claims, this may result in processing delays and possibly your application being refused.

About the information you give

The department is authorised to collect information provided on this form under Part 2 of the *Migration Act 1958* 'Control of Arrival and presence of Non-Citizens'. The information provided will be used for assessing your eligibility for a visa to travel, enter and remain in Australia and for other purposes relating to the administration of the Migration Act, for example, to assist migrants with settling in Australia or for ensuring compliance with the Migration Act.

The information provided might also be disclosed to agencies who are authorised to receive information relating to adoption, border control, business skills, citizenship, education, health assessment, health insurance, health services, law enforcement, payment of pensions and benefits, taxation, superannuation, review of decisions and state/territory economic development departments and agencies.

The department has authority under the *Migration Act 1958* to collect a range of personal identifiers from non-citizens, including visa applicants, in certain circumstances.
