**AUTHORISATION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE AUSTRALIAN COMMERCE
AND INDUSTRY OFFICE, TAIPEI, TAIWAN TO BE OFFICERS FOR
THE PURPOSES OF THE *MIGRATION ACT 1958***

I, *PHILIP RUDDOCK*, Minister for Immigration and Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs, acting under paragraph (f) of the definition of "officer" in subsection 5(1) of the *Migration Act 1958* ("the Act");

1. REVOKE all previous Instruments authorising employees of the Australian Commerce and Industry office, Taipei, Taiwan to be officers for the purposes of the Act; and
2. AUTHORISE the persons, who are employees of the Australian Commerce and Industry Office in Taipei, Taiwan, occupying the positions listed in column 2 of the Schedule, to be officers for the purposes of the Act.
