**AUTHORISATION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE AUSTRALIAN SECURITY
INTELLIGENCE ORGANISATION TO BE OFFICERS FOR THE
PURPOSES OF THE *MIGRATION ACT 1958***

I, *PHILIP RUDDOCK*, Minister for Immigration and Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs, acting under paragraph (f) of the definition of "officer" in subsection 5(1) of the *Migration Act 1958* ("the Act"):

- (1) REVOKE all previous instruments authorising employees of the Australian Security Intelligence Organisation to be officers for the purposes of the Act; and
- (2) AUTHORISE the persons occupying, or for the time being performing the duties of, the following positions in the Australian Security Intelligence Organisation to be officers for the purposes of the Act:
