**NOTICE OF AGREEMENT WITH MALAYSIA
FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE TRANSMISSION OF ADVANCE PASSENGER
INFORMATION**

I, *PHILIP RUDDOCK*, Minister for Immigration and Multicultural Affairs, acting under regulation 1.17 and paragraph 3.10(5)(a) of the Migration Regulations 1994.

DECLARE that the Commonwealth of Australia has on 9 January 2001 entered into agreement with the Government of Malaysia in relation to the provision of information concerning international movement of air traffic and passengers on international flights.
