## Learn more English

- Sign up for community or TAFE English classes.
- Join discussion groups to keep practising your English.
- Ask Centrelink for a referral to the Language, Literacy and Numeracy Program if you are a job seeker.

- Use the internet to search for courses that might interest you.
- Visit universities or TAFEs to get course information.
- Enrol in a course at university, TAFE or online.

## Get a job

- Contact Centrelink for help finding a job.
- Search your local newspaper or the internet for job advertisements.

## Get involved in your community

- Join a community group to help with local events.
- Become a volunteer and help others.
- Join a social club or sports team to meet new people.

# Money

## Currency

- Cents – There are 100 cents in one dollar (\$).
- Notes – Australian paper money, five dollars or more.
- Coins – Australian money, made of metal, two dollars or less.

## Bank

- A place/organisation that stores and lends money.

## EFTPOS

- Payment using a machine that moves money from your bank account to the shop's bank account.

## Credit

- Payment using a card that pays for your purchases with the bank's money. You need to repay the bank by the due date.

## Bill

- A piece of paper showing how much money you owe for goods or services.

## Receipt

- A piece of paper listing things you have paid for.

## **Word meanings**

- **Resume/CV** – A list of your education and the jobs you have had.
- **Interview** – A meeting where you are asked questions to see if you are the best person for the job.
- **Qualifications** – Past education and jobs that will help you with a new job.
- **Candidate** – A person who is applying for a job.
- **Wage** – Your weekly pay.
- **Traineeship/apprenticeship** – Working and learning about your trade or job at the same time.

## Word meanings

- **Mark** – The result given to you for work done. For example, 80%.
- **Assessment** – Work you have to do to complete a course. For example, an assignment or exam.
- **Course** – A full program of study. For example, a course in nursing.
- **Unit** – One subject within a course. For example, I have to do a maths unit and an English unit for my teaching degree.
- **Semester** – One half of the school year.
- **Exam** – A test of what you have learnt in your studies.
