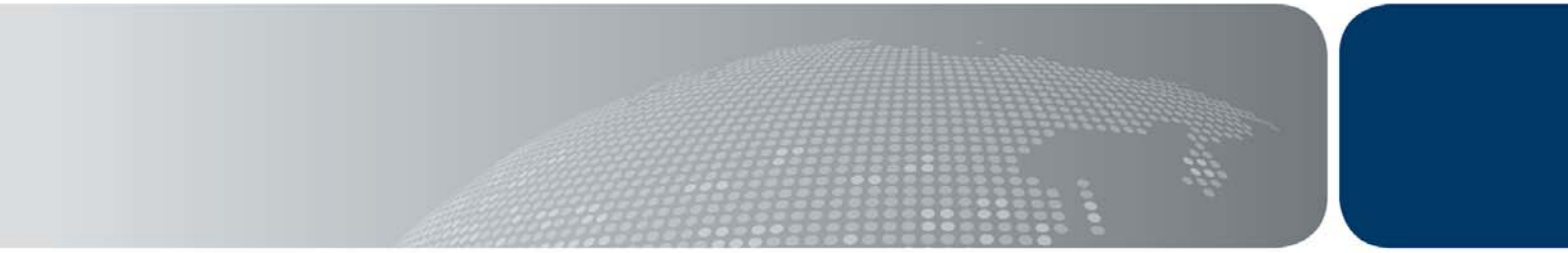

## Foreword

Departure statistics presented in this publication are derived from passenger card and other data relating to departures from Australia, where departing Australian residents have indicated an intention to permanently leave Australia or to stay overseas for 12 months or more. It is not a measure of the outflows from Australia's resident population through emigration. Specific information on Net Overseas Migration can be found in DIAC Fact Sheet 15, available at <<http://www.immi.gov.au/media/fact-sheets/15population.htm>> or from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS).

*Emigration* provides useful information on trends relating to the many people who travel to and from Australia.

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## Main Features

In the financial year of 2010-11:

In total

The number of permanent departures was 88 461, an increase of 2.5 per cent over the previous year.

Since 1975-76 permanent departures have ranged from a low of 18 100 in 1985-86 to 88 461 in 2010-11.

Permanent departures as a proportion of permanent arrivals was lowest (14.3 per cent) in 1987-88 and highest (69.4 per cent) in 2010-11.

Overseas born residents departing permanently as a proportion of total permanent departures has been approximately 50 per cent since 1998-99.

Of the total permanent departures 49.8 per cent were born in Australia (incl ext territories).

By country of birth

- ❑ Of the 44 416 permanent departures who were born overseas, 18.3 per cent were born in New Zealand, 16.1 per cent were born in the United Kingdom and 13.0 per cent were born in China (excl SARs and Taiwan).

By period of residence

- ❑ Of the 44 416 permanent departures who were born overseas, 71.2 per cent had resided in Australia for five years or more.
- ❑ 12.1 per cent of overseas born permanent departures had lived in Australia for less than two years.
- ❑ By major region, persons born in South America, Central America and the Caribbean had the highest proportion of permanent departures who had resided in Australia for five years or more at 74.8 per cent, closely followed by persons born in Oceania (73.5 per cent), Sub-Saharan Africa (73.4 per cent) and Southeast Asia (73.3 per cent). Persons born in Central Asia had the lowest corresponding proportion at 57.6 per cent (from a low base of 118 persons in total).

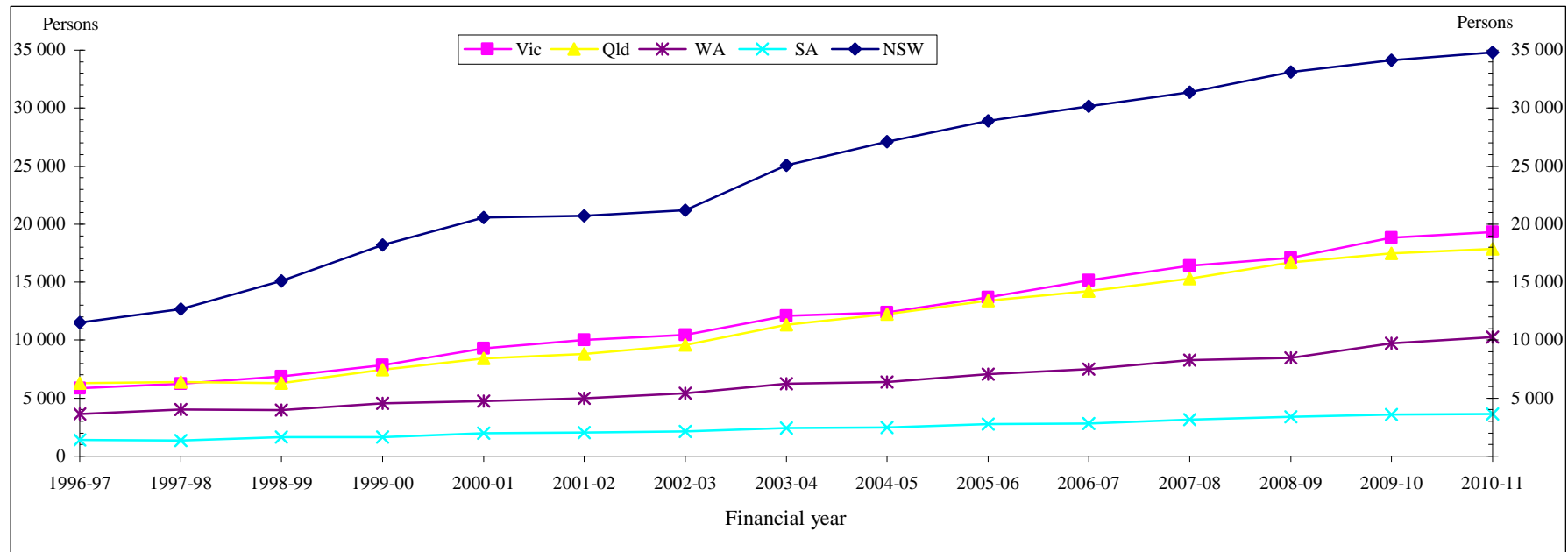
By age and state/territory of residence

- ❑ The age distribution of permanent departures is similar for all states and territories. The age group 25-34 years was the largest, followed by the 35-44 years age group.
- ❑ For all states and territories more than 40 per cent of permanent departures were aged 25-44 years. This age group ranged from a low of 43.3 per cent for the Northern Territory to a high of 52.1 per cent for Victoria.
- ❑ New South Wales (39.3 per cent) was the state where the largest number of permanent departures previously resided, followed by Victoria (21.8 per cent) and Queensland (20.2 per cent).

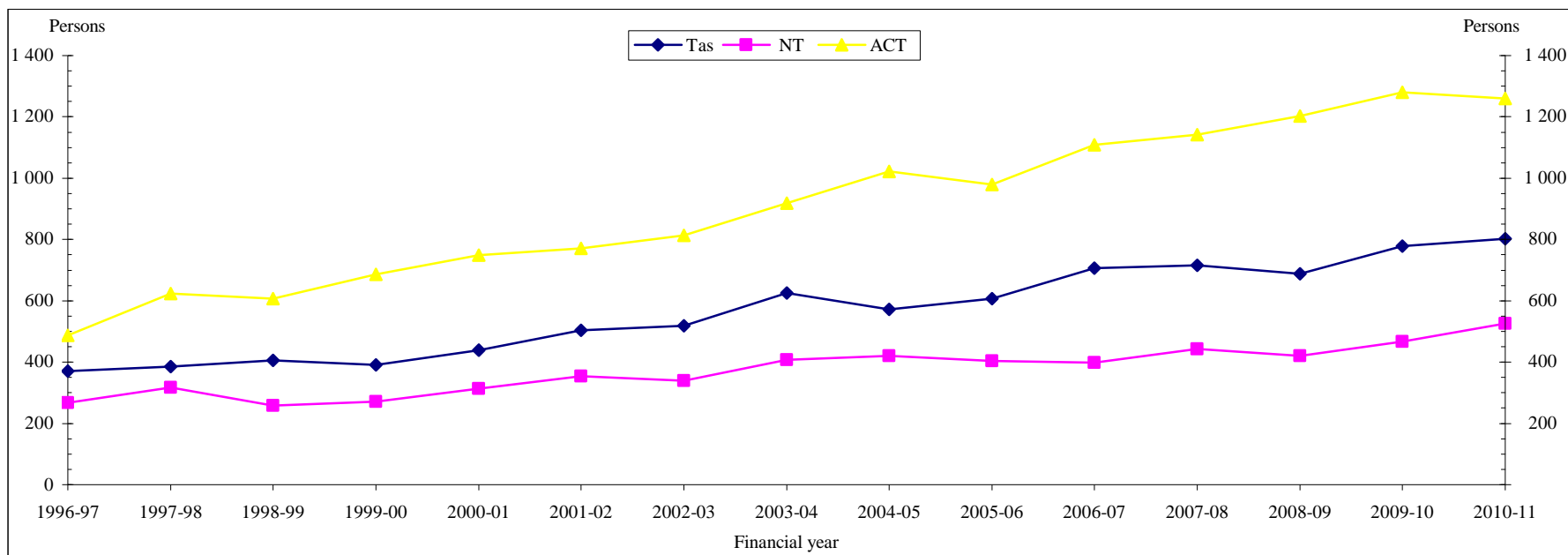
### By country of future residence

- ❑ The main countries of intended residence for all permanent departures were the United Kingdom (17.1 per cent), New Zealand (16.5 per cent), the United States of America (9.1 per cent) and Singapore (7.9 per cent).
- ❑ For major source countries, the highest proportions of the overseas born permanent departures who indicated the same country of future residence as their birthplace were New Zealand 80.1 per cent, Hong Kong (SAR of China) 75.9 per cent, China (excl SARs and Taiwan) 68.0 per cent and the United Kingdom 56.9 per cent .
- ❑ In 2010-11, 60.4 per cent of permanent departures who were born overseas indicated they were returning to the country of their birthplace.
- ❑ For the 10 years 2001-02 to 2010-11, the major countries of future residence for Australia born permanent departures have been the United Kingdom 21.4 per cent (74 386), New Zealand 15.3 per cent (53 233) and the United States of America 13.8 per cent (47 943).
- ❑ For the 10 years 2001-02 to 2010-11, the major countries of future residence for overseas born permanent departures have been New Zealand 23.7 per cent (81 679), the United Kingdom 13.1 per cent (45 027) and Hong Kong (SAR of China) 9.6 per cent (33 145).

## Explanatory notes

### Introduction

This report presents an analysis of permanent departures from Australia. Statistics of persons departing from and arriving in Australia are based on information from Incoming and Outgoing Passenger cards supplied by passengers to the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) on arrival in and departure from Australia and supplemented from passenger and visa information systems.

### Definitions

- Permanent departures - Residents departing permanently.
- Settlers/permanent arrivals - Persons arriving in Australia who hold migrant visas, regardless of stated intended period of stay, New Zealand citizens who indicate an intention to settle, and those who are otherwise eligible to settle (for example, overseas-born children of Australian citizens).
- Long term movement - Temporary visa holders arriving and residents departing temporarily with the intention to stay in Australia or abroad for twelve months or more, and the departure of temporary visa holders and the return of residents who had stayed in Australia or abroad for twelve months or more.

### Occupation

This data item describes a traveller's stated usual occupation prior to arrival in Australia and does not necessarily reflect occupation in Australia.

Statistics showing settler arrivals by occupation have been classified using the *Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations* (ANZSCO) First Edition, which has replaced the *Australian Standard Classification of Occupations* (ASCO) Second Edition from 1 July 2010.

In ANZSCO first edition, the number of major groups has decreased from nine to eight. Because of this, comparisons between current and previous time periods cannot be shown.

The major groups are:

- Managers
- Professionals
- Technicians and Trades Workers
- Community and Personal Service Workers
- Clerical and Administrative Workers

- Sales Workers
- Machinery Operators and Drivers
- Labourers

The tables in this publication include a number of categories which are not strictly 'occupation groups' for example 'Not in Employment', 'Not in the Labour Force', and 'Not Stated'. 'Not in Employment' refers to persons who have stated that they have been unemployed. 'Not in the Labour Force' includes children, persons stating 'home duties' as their occupation, students and retired persons. 'Not Stated' refers to those persons whose occupation description is not sufficiently specific to enable the allocation of precise ANZSCO codes.

For further information about ANZSCO, and for copies of the classification, please contact the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

### Classification of countries and regions

Statistics in this publication are classified to regions and countries based on the ABS Standard Australian Classification of Countries (SACC). The classification is based on the concept of geographic proximity. It groups neighbouring countries into broad geographic areas on the basis of their similarity in terms of social, cultural, economic and political characteristics.

The country classification used in this report is listed on page 55. In the tables in this publication some minor groups have been combined due to space limitations. For further information about SACC and for copies of the classification please contact the ABS.

### Australia and External Territories

Following amendments to Section 17(a) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1901 - 1973 effective 1 July 1992, the territories of Christmas Island and Cocos (Keeling) Islands now form part of geographic Australia. The Jervis Bay Territory has always been a territory in its own right, and following self-government for the ACT it is no longer included with the ACT for statistical purposes. These three territories are classified as the ninth state/territory of Australia.

Australian External Territories comprises the statistical units of Norfolk Island and Other Australian External Territories.

### Former Czechoslovakia

Separate data for the federation of the Czech republic and Slovakia has been available since

January 1993. Consequently the separate figures for the individual countries were likely to be significantly understated.

### Former Yugoslavia

Separate data for the federation of Serbia and Montenegro has been available since July 1998, Montenegro declared its independence on 3 June 2006. Prior to July 1998 the *Former Yugoslavia nfd* component was a substantial proportion of total Former Yugoslavia. Consequently the separate figures for the individual countries were likely to be significantly understated.

### Former USSR

The separate figures for component countries of the former USSR are likely to be understated and should be used with caution.

### Ethiopia and Eritrea

Caution is also required when using data for Ethiopia. This figure may include arrivals born in Eritrea since settlers who reported Ethiopia as their country of birth were coded as such, despite the fact that they may have been born in what is now called Eritrea.
