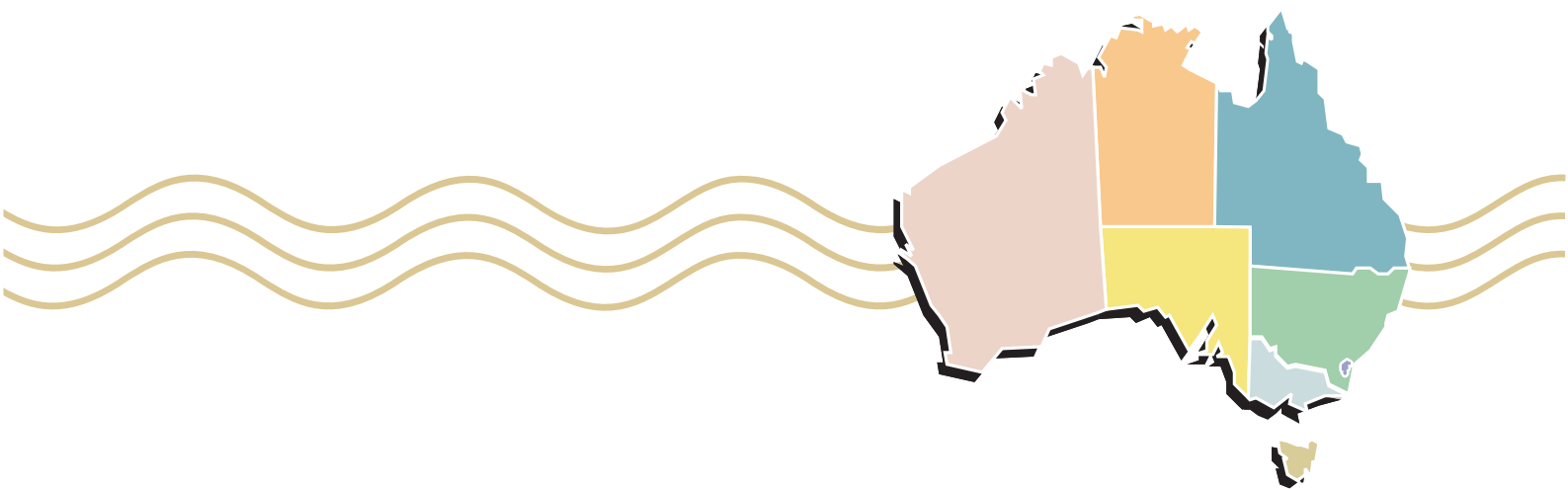

From 2001-02, data for permanent and long-term arrivals and departures have each been adjusted by "migration adjustments" for the effect of changes in travel intentions.

(b) The percentage contributions of permanent and long-term movement prior to 2001-02 are based on the net migration totals before adjustment for category jumpers.
