New Zealand movement

- At 30 June 2007, an estimated 504 000 New Zealand citizens were present in Australia, an increase of 7.2 per cent from a year earlier.
 - The New Zealand-born in Australia had a higher participation rate in the labour market than the Australia-born (78.0 per cent compared with 68.6 per cent).
 - The New Zealand-born in Australia had a marginally lower unemployment rate than the Australia-born (4.0 per cent compared with 4.1 per cent).
 - About 63.2 per cent of New Zealanders in Australia had described themselves as Australian residents on their last arrival in Australia.
