Important: Original documents should not be provided unless requested. Please provide 'certified copies' of original documentation. Documents not in English must be accompanied by accredited English translations.

Forms and Charges	Check Box
Form 47OF <i>Application for migration to Australia by other family members</i> A completed form 47OF, signed in all the relevant places. Each person included in the form, who is aged 18 years or over, must have signed the Australian values statement.	
Form 40 <i>Sponsorship for migration to Australia</i> A completed form 40 from your sponsor.	
Form 47A <i>Details of child or other dependant family member aged 18 years or over</i> A completed form 47A.

Personal Documents	Check Box
<p>Documents to prove your identity – a certified copy of your birth registration showing both parents’ names. If you do not have a birth certificate and are unable to get one, you must provide a certified copy of the identification pages of at least one of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • passport • family book showing both parents’ names • identification document issued by the government • documents issued by a court that verifies their identity. <p>If you are in Australia, certified copies of the passports or travel documents you and your dependants used to enter Australia, and of any passports held since then.</p>	
<p>Four recent passport size photographs (45mmx35mm) of you and any other person included in the application. These should be of the head and shoulders only, and should show the person facing the camera and against a plain background. You should print the name of the person on the back of each photograph.</p>	
<p>Evidence of your dependency on your relative in Australia.</p>	
<p>Evidence of your relationship with the sponsor.</p>	
<p>Evidence that the sponsor is an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident or eligible New Zealand citizen.</p>	
<p>If you or anyone included in the application is, or has been married, certified copies of the marriage certificate(s).</p>	
<p>If you or anyone included in the application has been permanently separated, divorced or widowed, a certified copy of the statutory declaration/separation certificate, divorce decree absolute or the death certificate of the deceased partner (as appropriate).</p>	
<p>If anyone in the application has changed his or her name (for example by marriage or deed poll), a certified copy of evidence of the name change.</p>	
<p>If any child included in the application is adopted, certified copies of the adoption papers.</p>	
<p>Certified copies of documents to verify custody and access arrangements for children under 18 years of age. This is not required if both parents are included in the application.</p>	
<p>If you have served in the armed forces of any country, certified copies of military service record or discharge papers.</p>
