Online Tourist Visa Applications

Applications for some Australian visas can be made using a computer with an Internet connection. To submit an online application for a visa, clients must hold a valid passport that should be valid for at least 6 months.

This service is in addition to making applications by mail or in person at a departmental office in Australia or an Australian Government office overseas. Apply online via the Internet

This service is currently available to passport holders from specified countries and regions only. These are listed on the Electronic Tourist Visa - Eligible Passports list. **See:**

If you are eligible, you can apply by either:

- using a registered travel agent, airline service or specialist provider to lodge a Tourist visa application on your behalf. A number of travel agents, airlines and specialist service providers have registered with the department to access this service. Australian Visa Label Requirements

If you are granted an electronic Tourist visa you do not need a visa label in your passport. Instead, you will be sent notification of the grant of your visa via your nominated postal or email address. Please keep this notification as it describes the conditions that apply to your visa.

Benefits of eVisa

- You can lodge your application anytime, day or night from any computer connected to the Internet
- No label is required in your passport
- You can pay for the application online with accepted credit cards through the secure site
- You can check the status of your application online, any time day or night
- You will receive your decision by email
- A stay of up to 12 months, depending on the reason for your visit and your ability to support yourself during your stay in Australia
- The visa is electronic, so you don't have to visit an office to have a label affixed in your passport
