## Investor (Residence) Visa (Subclass 891)

### Application Document Checklist

This checklist is to assist you in lodging a fully documented application.

Do not provide original documents unless requested. You should provide 'certified copies' of original documentation. Documents not in English must be accompanied by accredited English translations.

#### Complete applications








You should ensure that you lodge a complete visa application. While the department may ask you to provide more information in order to determine whether you meet the criteria for grant of the visa, a decision on the visa application may be made solely on the information provided at the time of application.




**Note:** The Visa Application Charge will not be refunded if a decision is made to refuse to grant the visa because the applicant did not satisfy the criteria for grant of the visa.

It is important that you folio and present all documents in the order outlined below. It is essential that the pages are numbered from the bottom up. Please use subdividing tabs/flags in your application wherever the flag symbol (🚩) is shown.

**Important:** Please do not undertake a health check unless requested to do so.

<b>Forms Required for Making a Valid Application</b>	<b>Folio Numbers</b> (Number folios from bottom up)
<p>A completed Form 47BU.</p> <p>The form must be signed in all the relevant places and each person included in the form, who is aged 18 years or over.</p> <p><b>See:</b> <a href="#">Form 47BU</a> <i>Application for a Business Skills (Permanent) visa</i></p>	
<p><a href="#">Form 927</a> <i>State/Territory notification: Business Skills class</i></p>	
<p>Visa application charge.</p> <p><b>See:</b> <a href="#">Business Development visa charges</a></p>	
<b>Designated Investment</b>	
<p>Evidence you have held a Designated Investment of AUD1 500 000 for four years. If the investment has already matured then the evidence can be in the form of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• written or emailed confirmation from the Treasury Corporation</li> <li>• bank statements confirming repayment of the amount.</li> </ul>	
<b>Residence Requirement</b>	
<p>You need to have been a resident in Australia as a subclass 162 Investor (Provisional) visa holder for a total of at least two years in the four years immediately prior to the visa application. The two year period in Australia does not need to be continuous.</p>	
<b>Business or Investment Record and History</b>	
<p>Overview of your business or investment activities in Australia. Please provide a short summary of any activities undertaken in Australia in addition to holding the Designated Investment.</p>	
<b>Commitment to Business and/or Your Investment Activity</b>	
<p>A one page summary of your proposed business or investment intentions in Australia in the long-term.</p>	
<p>Include any investigation undertaken into the Australian business or investment operating environment.</p>	
<b>Personal Documents</b>	
<p>Certified copies of passport or travel documents of all persons included in the application.</p>	

<p><a href="#">Form 47A</a> <i>Details of child or other dependent family member aged 18 years or over</i></p> <p>This form needs to be completed for all dependants aged 18 years or over.</p>	
<p>For each dependant who is not the holder of a Business Skills (Provisional) visa subclass 160 -165, provide:</p> <p>i. evidence of dependency if aged 18 or over (for example evidence of current studies)</p>	
<p>ii. certified copy of adoption or birth certificate or the family book, showing names of both parents or adoptive parents</p>	
<p>iii. certified copy of the marriage certificate (if applicable).</p>	
<p>If anyone in the application has changed his or her name (for example by marriage or deed poll), provide a certified copy of evidence of the name change.</p>	
<p>Certified copies of documents to verify custody and access arrangements for children under 18 years of age. This is not required if both parents are included in the application.</p>	
<p>One recent passport sized photograph (45mm x 35mm) of you and any other person included in the application.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These should be of the head and shoulders only against a plain background.</li> <li>• Print the name of the person on the back of each photograph.</li> </ul>	
<p>If you have served in the armed forces of any country in the last 10 years, provide certified copies of military service record or discharge papers.</p>	
<p>A completed form 80 for you and each member of your family unit aged 17 years or over, whether applying or not.  <b>See:</b> <a href="#">Form 80</a> <i>Personal particulars for character assessment</i></p>	
<p>An AFP National Police Check for you and each member of your family unit aged 17 years or over:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• whether applying or not</li> <li>• who, in the last 10 years, has been in Australia for 12 months or more since turning 16.</li> </ul> <p><b>See:</b> <a href="#">AFP National Police Checks</a></p>	
<p>Police clearances for you and each member of your family unit aged 17 years and over:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• whether applying or not</li> <li>• from each country where, in the last 10 years, that person has lived for 12 months or more since turning 16.</li> </ul> <p><b>See:</b> <a href="#">Character and Penal Clearance Requirements</a></p>
