Application Document Checklist

Do not provide original documents unless requested. You should provide 'certified copies' of original documentation. Documents not in English must be accompanied by accredited English translations.

You should ensure that you lodge a complete visa application. While the department may ask you to provide more information in order to determine whether you meet the criteria for grant of the visa, a decision on the visa application may be made solely on the information provided at the time of application.

Note: The Visa Application Charge (VAC) will not be refunded if a decision is made to refuse to grant the visa because the applicant did not satisfy the criteria for grant of the visa.

Full payment of the VAC. See: Specialist Entry Visa Charges	
Documents and information the applicant needs to provide	✓
Certified copy of the page in your passport that shows the photo and personal details.	
Certified copy of evidence of the name change for anyone included in the application who has changed their name (for example by marriage or deed poll).	

Details of position	✓
A signed declaration by your employer. See: Employer's Declaration (97KB Word file)	
A signed declaration by you. See: Employee's Declaration (97KB Word file)	
Letter of support from the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.	
Health documents	✓
Everyone included in the application must meet health requirements. See: Health Requirements	
Character documents	✓
If an applicant's stay in Australia, including any time already spent here, is more than 12 months, police clearances must be obtained. This applies to you and anyone else included in the application who is 16 years of age or older. See: Character and Penal Clearance Requirements
