Retirement Visa (Subclass 410)

Application Document Checklist

Only current Subclass 410 holders are eligible for a further Subclass 410 visa. Some previous holders **may** be eligible for renewal and should contact the Retirement Visas Processing Unit in Perth for further information.

You should ensure that you lodge a completed visa application. While the department may ask you to provide more information in order to determine whether you meet the criteria for grant of the visa, a decision on the visa application may be made solely on the information provided at the time of application.

Note: The Visa Application Charge will not be refunded if a decision is made to refuse to grant the visa because the applicant did not satisfy the criteria for grant of the visa.

Important: Do not provide original documents unless requested. You should provide 'certified copies' of original documentation. Documents not in English must be accompanied by accredited English translations.

Complete applications are likely to be processed more quickly. Incomplete applications may be delayed.

Forms, fees and charges	✓
Complete Form 1383 <i>Application for a temporary visa for retirees</i> . See: Form 1383 <i>Application for a temporary visa for retirees</i> All relevant sections of Form 1383 must be completed. Please include two recent passport sized photographs of each person included on the application form. Both you and your partner (if applicable) are included on the same application form.	
You must pay the correct visa application charge. See: Retirement Visa Charges	

Health insurance	✓
Evidence of having current and continuous (while in Australia) adequate health insurance for each applicant included on the Form 1383. Evidence should include the date the insurance is paid to and the level of cover.	
Personal details	✓
Certified copy of the bio-data page (information / photograph page) of a current passport for each applicant included on Form 1383. Please do not send passports with the application.	
Certified copy of any change in name since the previous retirement visa application (for example marriage certificate, deed poll) - if applicable.	
Certified copy of any change in marital status since the previous retirement visa application (for example marriage certificate, divorce documents, death certificate) – if applicable.	
Health requirements	✓
Applicants may be required to undergo a chest x-ray and a medical examination. Please do not undergo any health assessments prior to lodging your application – your case officer will write to you and advise what (if any) health assessments will be required. See: Health Requirements	
Character requirements	✓
An AFP National Police Check for each applicant who has spent a cumulative period of 12 months or more in Australia in the last 10 years. As this is usually the case for Retirement visa holders an AFP National Police Check Clearance is normally required. See: AFP National Police Checks	
An Overseas Police clearance is required from each country where an applicant has spent a cumulative period of 12 months or more in the past 10 years. If you or your partner (if applicable) provided a police clearance for a particular country when you previously applied for this visa you may be required to provide an updated clearance if you have since visited that country. See: Character and Penal Clearance Requirements
